

### Checklist for a German national visa

#### -Au Pair-

Before filling out the application form and booking an appointment, please prepare the following documentation for your visa:

<input type="checkbox"/>	valid <b>passport</b> (issued within the last 10 years and with at least 12 months validity left after the scheduled return; passports with observations regarding the front page cannot be accepted) with at least two empty pages
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Application form</b> & declarations duly signed
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Copy of your passport's data page</b> (A4 size copy)
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>3 passport pictures</b> according to biometric specifications
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Au Pair Contract</b> with a German family along with completed questionnaire ( <a href="#">here</a> )
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Informal invitation letter</b> from the German family
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Proof of German knowledge (A1 Level)</b> i.e. certificate issued by Max Mueller Bhavan/Goethe Institute or the Deutsch Center (Malleswaram)
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Birth Certificate</b> (with an attested English translation)
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Demand Draft or cash</b> for the visa fees

Please prepare two application sets with the above-mentioned documents and bring your original certificates along. Please do not staple any documents

Applications for au pairs will only be accepted from applicants who are **18 years of age and not older than 27 years at the time of application.**

Kindly note that the German Missions reserve the right to ask for additional documents for which additional fees would be charged.

The submission of the above-mentioned documents does not guarantee that a visa is granted. Submission of incomplete documentation or refusal to appear for a visa interview may result in the rejection of your application.
