- 3. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of considering your application for funding in the form of an allocation. The legal basis for the processing is Article 6 (1) (e) of the GDPR in conjunction with section 3 of the Federal Data Protection Act, as the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller.
- 4. Whatever decision is taken on your application, your personal data will be stored for processing purposes by the Federal Foreign Office (the mission abroad) for a period of at least one year. Since your application is currently being processed, we cannot yet predict how long your personal data will be stored for. If your application is approved, we will normally store your data for a period of five years after the expiry of the authorised period.
- 5. As a data subject you have the following rights:
- Right of access (Article 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification (Article 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure (Article 17 GDPR)¹
- Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 GDPR)
- Right to data portability (Article 20 GDPR)
- Right to object to processing (Article 21 GDPR).
- 6. You also have the right to complain to a data protection authority about the processing of your personal data.
