<input type="checkbox"/>	1 biometric passport photo , 35 x 45 mm, not older than six months with a bright background and frontal view of the face (please do not attach the picture to the application form). Digitally-altered passport pictures will not be accepted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Detailed CV (up to date, in German or English including the city, province or territory of the employer or educational institution)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Motivation letter
<input type="checkbox"/>	Au Pair contract with an Au Pair agency or family in Germany stating the full address (including postal code) of your Au Pair family
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of German language skills , at least level A1
<input type="checkbox"/>	Self-addressed envelope (An Post only) with postage (9,50 Euros stamp) <i>Or Envelope and stamps can be purchased for 12 Euros at the Embassy</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Visa fee 75,- Euros (contactless payments are not available)
	After approval: Health insurance covering you for the duration of your Au Pair contract
