

# Visa for a German national Visa

### Self employment

# (Section 21 Residence Act)

#### **Basic information**

- Documents not in the English language must be submitted with a certified German translation. A translation of the personal data page of the passport is, however, not required.
- Certificates, diplomas, etc. must be presented in the original. Your original documents will be returned to you once your application has been processed.
- The visa must be approved by the Federal Employment Agency and, where applicable, the competent foreigners' authority in Germany. The visa can only be issued when these approvals have been received.
- Processing time is as a rule ca. 3 months but can take longer in individual cases.
- Flight reservations are not required to apply for a visa please only book when you have received your visa.
- The mission abroad reserves the right to request further documents.
- Missing documentation delays the procedure and can result in your application being rejected.
- Please do not contact the Embassy to check the status of your application during the normal processing period. Such inquiries are extremely time-consuming for the visa section and can thus not be answered.
- Please do not staple the documents.

#### **General information**

According to Section 21 of the German Residence Act, a foreigner may be granted a visa for the purpose of self-employment, if

1.an economic interest or a regional need applies,

2.the activity is expected to have positive effects on the economy and

3.personal capital on the part of the foreigner or a loan undertaking is available to realise the business idea.

As the competent bodies at the planned business location assess whether the abovementioned conditions for commercial self-employed activities by foreigners have been met in your case, **you are advised to contact the relevant authorities and enquire about special prerequisites before filing your visa application with us.** The authorities you would need to contact are, for example, the Aliens Authority, the Chamber of Commerce and Industry and the authority regulating admission to the profession concerned. Before filling out the application form and booking an appointment, please prepare the following documentation for your application:

Proof of adequate health insurance cover			
If as an employee you are subject to mandatory statutory health insurance, you must bear in mind that this insurance can only begin when you take up residence in Germany and enter into employment. If you enter Germany beforehand, private health insurance must be taken out for the period prior to employment beginning and prior to being eligible for statutory health insurance. In its terms and conditions, travel health insurance can exclude protection if a long-term or permanent stay is planned. So-called incoming travel insurance can also contain such exclusions.
